

# Information bulletin – Register of Participants changes in the VEET website

Version 1.0 – 30 August 2018

## Overview

The Essential Services Commission has implemented a new feature to the Victorian Energy Efficiency Target (VEET) website ([www.veet.vic.gov.au](http://www.veet.vic.gov.au)) that affects all accredited persons' public register information on the website.


## Who is impacted by these changes

All accredited persons (APs) under the VEET scheme.

## Changes to the VEET website

### New information feature in the Register of Participants

We have added a new 'Services' field in the Register of Participants that can be used to provide search results based on whether your business, for each activity type, only undertake upgrades and facilitate certificates, or provides 'aggregator' services facilitates certificates only (i.e. accredited persons who create certificates on behalf of third parties) (see Figure 1 below). This will help tradespeople, businesses and organisations (such as local councils) find APs who provide 'aggregator' services for a particular activity type.

Like all other information used to populate this register, you will need to update your details via the 'Public Register Info' menu item in your VEET website account.

In the public register information page (see Figure 2 below), you will see the addition of two extra fields 'Undertakes upgrade and facilitates certificates' and 'Does not undertake upgrade – facilitates certificates only'.

Click the 'Edit' links and select the appropriate tick boxes under each of these fields for each activity type. Updates made here will be reflected in the Register of Participants for activities where the 'Show in public register' check box has been ticked.
